
Human induced Pluripotent Stem Cell (iPSC) Workshop 2018

The Centre for Stem Cell Research (CSCR), Vellore, is a unit of the Institute of Stem Cell and Regenerative Medicine (inStem), Bengaluru. CSCR has been established as a collaboration between inStem, the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India and Christian Medical College, Vellore. CSCR aims to use stem cell science to better understand human diseases and develop novel cell-based therapies through translational research including basic science, animal models for diseases and clinical trials.

CSCR is initiating a 1-week workshop on induced pluripotent stem cells (iPSCs). This program will focus on generation, culture and, characterization of iPSCs. The workshop combines hands-ontraining and lectures on these aspects as well as their applications.

Workshop Topics:

- Basic maintenance and cell culture of iPSCs
- Thawing and freezing of iPSCs
- Generation and characterization of iPSCs

Eligibility:

This workshop is open to research fellows, postdoctoral fellows and investigators working in the area of pluripotent stem cells. Preference will be given to those who are involved in this area research with projects funded by Indian Government funding agencies.
